COMPLETE CASE ROADMAP

PURPOSE

This roadmap explains how every document in this package fits into a complete Liberty Dialogues case from beginning to end.

STAGE 1 — ORIENTATION

Read: Start Here, History Overview, Context, Court Rules Digest, What Next.

Objective: Understand the framework before entering the process.

STAGE 2 — PREPARATION

Use: Trial Preparation Checklist, One-Page Checklist, Traffic Checklist, Jury Day Timeline.

Objective: Prepare facts, documents, witnesses, and courtroom posture.

STAGE 3 — VOIR DIRE

Use: Voir Dire Guide and Voir Dire Questions.

Objective: Identify bias and confirm jurors can follow the burden of proof.

STAGE 4 — PRE-TRIAL FILINGS

Use: Motion for Recognition of Pro Per Status, Certificate of Service, Motion for Continuance (if needed).

Objective: Establish status and preserve fairness.

STAGE 5 — COURT ENTRY

Use: Oral Script – Pro Per Status Request.

Objective: Enter the proceeding calmly and establish your position.

STAGE 6 — TRIAL

Use: Opening Statement, Cross Examination, Objections Guide, Preserving Error Script, Closing Argument.

Objective: Require the government to prove its case and preserve the record.

STAGE 7 — POST-VERDICT

Use: Constitutional Violation Memo, Objection to Sentencing, Motion to Vacate, Objection to Denial of Latitude.

Objective: Preserve rights and challenge improper rulings.

STAGE 8 — APPEAL

Use: Notice of Appeal, Stay of Enforcement, Appellate Timeline, Court of Appeals Brief Template.

Objective: Escalate preserved issues for review.

STAGE 9 — EXTRAORDINARY RELIEF

Use: Federal Habeas Preservation Outline and Writ of Prohibition/Mandamus Outline.

Objective: Address jurisdictional overreach and constitutional violations when ordinary remedies are insufficient.

FINAL PRINCIPLE

This package is intended to be used as a complete case system. Each document fits within a specific stage of the process. Follow the sequence and understand how each document supports the next.
